(A6006 WYMESWOLD TO ASFORDBY ROAD IN THE PARISHES OF ASFORDY,
GRIMSTON, BROUGHTON AND OLD DALBY AND WYMESWOLD, IN THE BOROUGH
OF MELTON AND CHARNWOOD) (IMPOSITION OF 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201

THE LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under Sections 5 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, the effect of which will be:

1. To impose a 50 mph Speed Limit on parts of A6006 Bypass Road, Loughborough Road and Saxelby Road, Asfordby, Loughborough Road and Main Street, Grimston, Paddys Lane and Gibsons Lane, Broughton and Old Dalby, Paddys Lane, Wide Lane, East Road and Hades Lane, Wymeswold

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a plan illustrating the proposals and an explanatory statement giving the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected during normal office hours at my offices, Room 200, County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester LE3 8RA, at the offices of Melton Borough Council, Parkside, Station Approach, Burton Street, Melton Mowbray, LE13 1GH and on the notice boards of Asfordby, Grimston, Broughton and Old Dalby and Wymeswold Parish Councils.
