COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT MEETING

Passenger transport is changing in Leicestershire and, at the same time as the county council is facing significant financial challenges, we are also trying to offer a better service to residents. The county council has developed a new Passenger Transport Policy and Strategy (PTPS) to ensure its passenger transport provision is fit for purpose and cost-effective.

We are reviewing all contracted services across the county. The review of services 23 (Melton Mowbray - Nether Broughton), 24 (Melton Mowbray - Bingham/Bottesford) and 25 (Melton Mowbray - Stathern) is now complete. The intended course of action is to integrate the three services and to change routes, timings and frequencies accordingly.
