PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Parish Council met in August and discussed the following applications:

21/00272/LBC 21/00271/FUL Manor Farm Main Road Nether Broughton
The Parish Council felt as long as LCC Highways departments recommendations were followed they had no objection.

20/00822/FUL amended plans - land next to The Crown Old Dalby
The Parish Councils views on this application remain the same.

21/00673/GDOOTH - telecoms mast Station Road
The Parish Council have no objections to this application.

21/00763/FUL 3 Blacksmiths Close Nether Broughton
The Parish Council have no objection to this application.

21/00720/FUL Enterprise Village - Single storey industrial unit B2/B8
The Parish Council have no objection to this application as long as it is for B2/B8 use.

21/00762/FUL Enterprise Village - New industrial unit on serviced development plateau with car parking and service provision - E(g)(previously B1), B2 & B8 use.
The Parish Council have no objection to this application as long as it is for B2 & B8 use

21/00864/FUL 2a Parnham Close Nether Broughton – side extension
The Parish Council have no objection to this application.

Hedges & Trees

If so, please cut it back to ensure safe passage for all pedestrians including those who are partially sighted and push chair and wheelchair users.

The Parish Council have just ordered some more new dog waste bins and they should be arriving shortly. Yellow pavement signage will also soon appear around the villages to remind dog owners to dispose of their dog waste correctly.
