

NETHER BROUGHTON AND OLD DALBY PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

PLANNING APPLICATIONS

The Parish Council met in September and discussed the following applications:

21/00839/FUL | Extension to existing storage warehouse | Brinvale Farm Broughton Lane Long Clawson Melton Mowbray LE14. The Parish Council felt that there was not sufficient information on the application for the use of the warehouse to make any comments and have requested more information.

4NB21/00733/FUL | Change of use of grazing land to earth embanked clay reservoir to store digestate | Vale View Farm Nottingham Lane Old Dalby LE14 3LX. The Parish Council although agreed in principal to the store digestate they are concerned with the impact on the traffic on Nottingham Lane and would like to see the road infrastructure improved and will be voicing their concerns.

21/00946/REM | Condition 2: Layout, Scale, External appearance of buildings, Access and Landscaping | Land Opposite 1 And 10 Station Lane Old Dalby. The Parish Council feel that this application is too large to discuss at a monthly meeting and have agreed to meet further to discuss this in greater detail before making any comments to Melton Borough Council.

21/00252/FULHH | Single storey side extension and landscaping to rear garden. | The Cottage 14 Chapel Lane Old Dalby LE14 3LA - amended plans. The Parish Council still have reservations regarding this application and access to the rear of the property.

The Parish Council noted the approval decision by Melton Borough Council Planning department of **21/00320** – Installation of air source heat pumps – Enterprise Village – Station Road

Speed Awareness

Our local PCSO Andrew French recently did a speed monitoring exercise on the A606 in Nether Broughton – During the 30 minutes he was monitoring speed from 16.15 – 16.45 one speeding ticket was issued and 4 letters of advice. PCSO Andrew French will be doing further speed monitoring around the parish in the next few weeks.

Beat Surgery

The Parish Council are happy to support Andrew French who is the new PCSO for our parish and who is going to hold a Beat Surgery on **Thursday 30 September at 7.00pm in Old Dalby Village Hall**. This will be for all villages including Nether Broughton and Queensway. Andrew will be happy to discuss with residents any concerns they have regarding the law and he is especially keen to do something about the speeding in all villages and will be pleased to take your concerns on this subject and discuss the way forward and what can be done. Hecadeck Lane Development

The Parish Council are very much aware of the recent traffic problems that have arisen with the new development on Hecadeck Lane.

The Parish Council have now taken up these traffic issues with Melton Borough Council Planning Department, and the local police PCSO Andrew French. Andrew French will be in contact with Grace Homes within the next few days to discuss these traffic issues to get them resolved.
